

HOW DO I USE IT?

3 Simple Steps!



Sweep

Sweep out area to be patched. Make sure to remove all loose debris, broken pieces of pavement and dust.



Fill

Fill pothole with EZ Street asphalt. For holes deeper than 50 mm compact material in 25 mm layers.



Compact

Compact the EZ Street asphalt to just over the level of the existing pavement.

HOW MUCH DO I NEED?

22 kg Bags	
0.42 m ²	
0.84 m ²	
1.25 m ²	
2.1 m ²	

(Measurements based on 25 mm depth)

ASK THE POTHOLE EXPERTS

1) What tools are required?

One person, a shovel, a broom, then a tamper or a car, whichever will help with compaction.

2) Can I apply EZ Street to a pothole that has water in it?

EZ Street works just as well in water, so just apply as normal. The water will be displaced, but be sure to compact.

3) What is EZ Street asphalt made of?

The highest quality ingredients, consisting of a refined gradation of rock and sand, and a proprietary polymer formulation.

4) Should I clean the pothole out before I fill it in with EZ Street asphalt?

Get as much of the loose debris out of the pothole. Drying or waiting for warmer weather is not necessary.

5) How long will the product last in the bag?

6 months to a year. EZ Street will still be pliable and usable.

6) Can I use EZ Street asphalt over concrete?

Yes, it will stick to concrete, brick, and a variety of other surfaces.

7) Sometimes after I patch a hole, the product appears to be "soft". Is there something wrong with it?

Not usually, really. The asphalt component of EZ Street asphalt is a viscous liquid, that reacts quite interestingly to changes in temperature. When it's a scorcher of a summer day out there, and you absolutely want to patch something, and you find that after you use the product, it appears "too loose" you can remedy this by sprinkling a bit of cement dust on the top of the patch.

8) How long before I can walk or drive over the repaired surface?

There's no wait time. The surface is instantly ready for traffic.
